1. All Players has must DOB proof .
2. The organizing Committee has the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason.
3. Only for Punjab residents (For Tricity Players Either schooling/Residence/ Job/Business must be in Punjab)
4. The tournament will be played separately in Open and Girls categories.
5. Top two players in each category will be selected to represent Punjab in the Under 07 National Chess Championship 2023.
6. **Each participant must produce a valid certificate to prove his /her age. Certificates from School will not be accepted. Certificates should preferably be from the Panchayat, Municipality or Corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without date of birth certificates will not be allowed to participate.**

Tournament Rules:

System of Play: The tournament will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of Chess and FIDE Swiss System .

Default Time (Walk over Time) the default time will be 15 minutes

Tie Break: In case of a tie, the latest FIDE Rules shall come in to effect.

Electronic Devices: - All electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall.

Chief Arbiter decision will be final binding any or all kinds of disputes .

Parents and accompanying persons are not allowed inside tournament hall at all times.

Time Control:

45 Minutes plus 15 second increment from move 1.
