- 4. In addition to above the following Districts can field additional entries by virtue of three medal winners (gold, silver and bronze) secured by their players in the last 52<sup>nd</sup> Tamil Nadu State Women Chess Championship 2023 held at Tiruvarur. Gold (3) + Silver (2) Chennai, Bronze (2) Kanyakumari.
- 5. The host Thoothukudi DCA is entitled to field two additional entries.
- 6. Any player who remits the prescribed special entry fee of Rs.1500/-. All the entries should come through the **Respective District/Affiliated units**.
- 7. The TNSCA General Secretary can nominate one player.
- 8. Any Current National Champion in any category is to be seeded to All State Championships subject to age stipulation.
- 9. All WGMs and WIMs are seeded for Tamil Nadu State Women Chess Championship.
- 10. In the event of odd entry, the host Thoothukudi DCA is entitled add one more entry to make total number as even in each category.
- 11. Those who have qualified to represent the country in official FIDE events.

#### A Brief History of the College
