

AICF player registration is compulsory for all Indian players.

a. AICF player registration fee Rs 300/- for the year 2024-2025 has to be paid well before the start of tournament. It will be accepted only through online.

Accommodations: Players are required to arrange their own accommodation. However, upon request, organizers will provide some recommendations

System of play: FIDE Swiss System will be followed.

Time Control: 90 Minutes +30 Seconds increment from move 1.

Walkover Time: 30 Minutes.

Rounds: 9 Rounds.

Eligibility: The tournament is open for all players.

Appeals Committee: An Appeals Committee will be formed during the technical meeting.

Protests: Protests, if any against the decision of the arbiter stall be made in - writing with a protest fee Rs.1000/- (Rs. One thousand only) within 15 minutes of the incident. The protest fee is refundable only if the protest is upheld. The decision of the appeals committee on all protests shall be final and binding. Interpretation: For interpretation of the rules and deciding any point not covered by the rules, the decision of the tournament committee shall be final and binding.

Withdrawals: A player may withdraw at any stage of the event, after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.

One player will be given one (higher) Cash prize only.

The tournament will be conducted as per the latest FIDE Laws of Chess
