INVITATION:

Ananthi Chess Academy and Viyugam chess Academy on behalf of Tamil Nadu State Chess Association and All India Chess Federation (AICF), have the honour to invite all the State Associations and all schools* (any syllabus) in India to participate in the **49th NATIONAL SUB-JUNIOR OPEN (UNDER-15) & 40th NATIONAL SUB-JUNIOR GIRLS (UNDER-15) CHESS CHAMPIONSHIPS-2024** from 03rd November to 11th November 2024.

AGE LIMIT:

Players should be born on or after **01.01.2009**

AGE PROOF:

Each participant must produce a valid certificate to prove his/her age. Certificates from School will not be accepted. Certificates should preferably be from the panchayat, municipality or corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without date of birth certificates will not be allowed to participate. The date of birth certificates registered within one year of the birth of the player alone will be recognized and allowed to participate. No state association shall recommend any player who doesn't come under the above criteria.

If any doubt arises about the claimed age of a player, the tournament committee has the right to refer the player during the championship for a due evaluation of age by competent medical experts. A player, if declared over age by such experts shall not continue in the championship and the matter shall be reported to AICF. Protest about the age of players may be made to the chief arbiter in writing, along with a fee of Rs.5000/- per player. This will not be refunded. No protest about the age of a player will be entertained after the second round of the championship.

Only a coach or manager deputed by the participating state chess association can lodge such protests. The tournament committee has the right to decide the day, time and place for such medical evaluation of age.

AICF/organizers will have the right to refer any player to the medical evaluation of age at any time during the championship.

Players refusing to take the test, as decided by the tournament committee, shall be deemed to have failed the test and shall be disqualified from the championship.



PRIZES:

The cash prizes will be awarded to the first 20 players in each category amounting to Rs.4,50,000/- as given below:

ELIGIBILITY:

Subject to age limit, the following players can participate:

- (a) Four players in each category from every affiliated state association of AICF. If any association fails to send its quota, the vacancies so caused will not be filled.
- (b) The top four players from the 2023 National Sub-Junior (Under-15) Open & Girls Chess Championships (held in Maharashtra in December 2023) are eligible to participate as seeded players in their respective categories subject to age stipulation.
- (c) The top two players from the 2023 National U-13 Open and Girls Championships (held in Telangana in December 2023) are eligible to participate as seeded players in their respective categories.
- (d) The champions from the 2023 National Under-11 Open & Girls Chess Championships (held in Andhra Pradesh, October 2023) are eligible to participate as seeded players in their respective categories.
- (e) World champion in any over-the-board category from the year 2023, subject to age stipulation.
- (f) 2023 World No.2 & 3 Under-14 and Under-16 categories subject to age stipulation.
- (g) 2023 Asian U-16 top three rankers subject to age stipulation.
- (h) 2023 Asian Under-14 Champion.
- (i) The winner and runner-up of the 2023 National Sub Junior (U-15) Girls (Maharashtra) Championship are eligible to play in the open section subject to age stipulation.
- (j) The winner of the 2023 National Under-13 Girls (Telangana) Championship is eligible to play in the open section.
- (k) Current national over-the-board champion subject to age stipulation.
- (l) All GMs/IMs are seeded in the open section, and all WGMs/WIMs are seeded in girls' section subject to age stipulation.
- (m) Any other player who remits the prescribed special entry fee of Rs.6,250/. Such entries should come through the respective affiliated state association.
- (n) Host Ananthi Chess Academy/Viyugam Chess Academy/Tamil Nadu State Chess Association is entitled to fill two additional players in each category.
- (o) The AICF Secretary has a discretionary seat in each category in this championship.

ELIGIBILITY CONTINUATION:

(p) Two players in each category approved by AICF will be permitted from areas where no state association exists.

(q) If the number of participants at the start of the championship is an odd number in a category, the host association can add one entry to make it even.

(r) Only Indian nationals are eligible to participate in the championships.

(s) In addition to the above, three additional entries from the state which won gold, two entries from the state which won silver and one additional entry from the state which won bronze in the National Sub-Junior (Under-15) Chess Championships 2023 shall be accepted.

Open: Delhi (Gold) 3, Gujarat (Silver) 2, West Bengal (Bronze) 1

Girls: West Bengal (Gold & Silver) 5, Maharashtra (Bronze) 1

DRESS CODE:

As per AICF regulations on dress code for players participating in all the national championships, all state associations should send their players, including special/donor entry players, with proper uniforms (as regards special/donor entry players, the respective state chess associations may collect the cost of the uniform from the players). Players should at least wear uniform T-shirts/formal shirts (the same colour and brand with the name of the state printed prominently on the back and the state chess emblem on the front left side). The name/logo of the sponsors can be permitted. The above rule will also be applicable to special units.

Players without proper uniforms will not be permitted to take part in the championship.

>>>> This will be strictly enforced.



REGISTRATION:

All entries, including special entries, should come through the concerned state association. However, AICF will have the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason. The entry form should be sent together with an attested copy of the original date of birth certificate (Birth Certificates from Panchayat/Municipality/Corporation only accepted).

ENTRY FEE STRUCTURE:

Ordinary Entry: Rs.1,250/- (Rupees one thousand two hundred fifty only)

Special Entry: Rs. 6,250/- (Rupees six thousand two hundred fifty only)

There will be a **50% concession** in the entry fee for participants from the North Eastern States and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

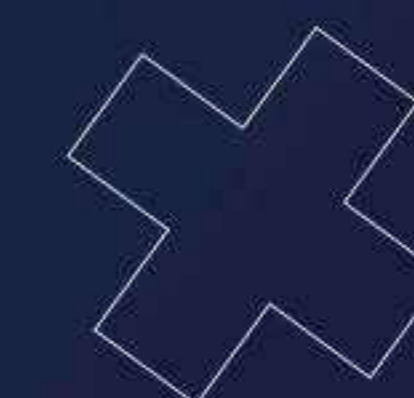

LATE FEE:

Please note that the entry fee structure is valid till **20th October 2024**. Thereafter, a late fee of Rs. 250/- per player will be levied. No entry will be accepted after **27th October 2024** (up to 18:00 hrs.).

Players from the same state shall not be paired against each other in the last round. However, they may be paired if there is no compatible opponent with the same point group or score group with a maximum difference of 1 point. It is applicable only for the top 50% score of the penultimate round.



DEFAULT TIME:

The default timing for arriving at the chess board is **15 minutes**. Those who arrive at the board 15 minutes after the start of the game will be declared lost.

TIME CONTROL:

The rate of play shall be **90 minutes** with an increment of 30 seconds per move from move number one.

CHESS CLOCKS:

Each participating state chess association must provide at least one clock in working order for every two players who entered the championship.

TIE-BREAK:

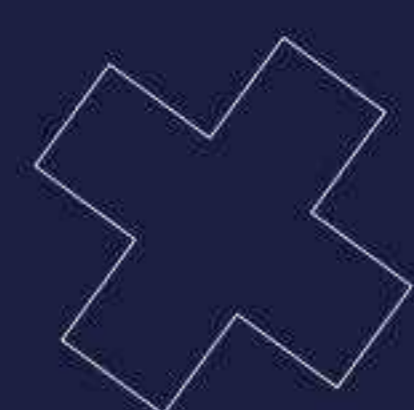
The following is the order of Tie-Breaks:

- (a) Buchholz Cut1
- (b) Buchholz
- (c) Sonneborn-Berger
- (d) Direct Encounter
- (e) The greater number of wins (forfeit included)
- (f) Number of wins with black pieces

In case of a tie, cash prizes will not be shared.

DRAW AGREEMENT:

Players shall not agree to a draw without the consent of the arbiter before each player makes 30 moves.



PROTEST:

Protests, if any, against the decision of the chief arbiter shall be made in writing with a **protest fee of Rs.3,000/-** within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The amount shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

APPEALS COMMITTEE:

Before the commencement of the tournament, a five-member appeals committee shall be formed by the AICF/TNSCA/Organizers. All the members and reserves shall be from different states. No member of the committee can vote on the dispute in which a player from his own state is involved, and in such case(s), the reserve member(s) shall take his/her place in the committee. **The decision of the appeals committee is final and binding on the players concerned.**

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:

The organizers will form a tournament committee for the smooth conduct of the national championship.

INTERPRETATION:

For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the rules of the tournament, the decision of the tournament director shall be final and binding on all. The tournament director has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules without prior notice. However, such changes or inclusion will be subject to AICF & TNSCA clearance. Such changes, however, will be displayed at the championship venue.

WITHDRAWAL:

If any player withdraws from the last two rounds in any national championship on medical grounds, he/she should undergo treatment by a doctor recommended and supervised by the tournament committee. The entry fee, once paid, shall not be refunded if the withdrawal from the championship is done after the publication of the first-round pairings.



DISQUALIFICATION:

No participant will leave the venue before the prize distribution (PD) function without the permission of the chief arbiter. The participants disregarding this rule will be suspended for one year. If a player does not attend the prize distribution function, they will forfeit their right to receive any prizes. It is mandatory to be present at the PD function to claim the prizes.

AICF REGISTRATION:

All participants in the national championship should be registered with AICF for the year 2024-2025. Online AICF registration is available on the website www.aicf.in.

Those who have paid the AICF registration fee but are yet to receive the AICF registration card should send a photocopy of the acknowledgement of having paid the fee to organizers of earlier tournaments or to their association. Before the start of the championship, all the players must be registered with AICF for the year 2024-2025. **No entry will be accepted without an AICF player's registration for 2024-2025.**

ELECTRONIC DEVICES:

All electronic items, including wristwatches (all types of watches), are not allowed in the tournament hall.

If a player is found to possess a mobile (switched on/off) or a wristwatch, either on the person or in a separate bag, he will be declared as lost. Players wearing any kind of watch during the game will also be declared lost.

INCOME TAX:

Existing provisions of income tax as of the date of the championship are applicable for prize money.

A. ACCOMMODATION:

Free dormitory accommodation will be provided to all the selected and seeded Players and one Manager from each state.

B. ACCOMMODATION:

For other players/accompanier who are not willing to stay in city hotels and lodges, an affordable unfurnished, separate male/female dormitory accommodation with common restrooms is available at the venue for Rs. 5000/- per person, including (breakfast, lunch, dinner) for all 9 days.

Interested person to avail the accommodation can make the bookings on www.ananthichessacademy.com

Only 50 dormitory accommodations are available on a first come, first serve basis. Dormitory accommodation requests are to be reserved only through online booking.

EACH DORMITORY CAN ACCOMMODATE 8-10 PERSONS

E-mail/call/text-based booking requests are not entertained.

Reporting place for accommodation: Indoor stadium Adhiyamaan College of Engineering.

BOARDING:

A lump sum of Rs. 1500/- (Rupees one thousand five hundred only) will be paid by the organizers towards the boarding expenses only to the affiliated state association seeded and selected players who play this championship under normal entry fee.

All category students will be allowed to stay only in their respective gender dormitory.

CAFETERIA / REFRESHMENT & OTHER FOOD AMENITIES:

Food and refreshments will be available on a payment basis in the college food court.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

The tournament will be held at the indoor stadium of Adhiyamaan College.

If a person disturbs the tournament by any means, the tournament committee/director will have the full rights to take the necessary action against them. In case of any discrepancy the tournament director's decision will be final.

Kindly take care of your personal belongings; the tournament committee will not be responsible for any lost items.

For players depending on public transportation/cab service for local transport, Govt./private buses are available from Hosur bus stand.

Metropolitan city cab service aggregators like Ola and Uber etc., are not available at Hosur for local transportation. Players are requested to plan accordingly and use local rented auto rickshaws and private cab services to reach the venue on time.
