

Important Instruction

- 1. Age Group Prize-Player will get prize in own his/her Group.
- 2. Players qualified for more than one prizes will be considered only for the higher prize.
- 3. All outstation Players & Parents must have ID proof for Staying.
- 4. The organizing Committee has the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason.

Tournament Rules:

- 1. System of Play: The tournament will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of Chess and FIDE Swiss System with tentative 9 rounds (number of rounds may alter basis decision in players meeting)
- 2. Default Time (Walk Over Time) The default time will be 15 minutes
- 3. Tie Break: In case of a tie, the latest FIDE Rules shall come in to effect. The Cash prizes however will not be shared.
- 4. Electronic Devices: All electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall.
- 5. Parents and accompanying persons are not allowed inside tournament hall at all times.
- 6. Indian Income Tax Act and Rules will be applicable
- 7. Due to any unforeseen scenario, if the event needs to be cancelled, then Waves obligation is limited to refunding the entry fee paid by the players.

Places to visit in Jaipur



AMBER PALACE

Amber (pronounced Amer) is at a distance of about 11 kilometres from Jaipur. Now a UNESCO World Heritage Site, it was the bastion of the Kachwahas of Amber, until the capital was moved to the plains, to what is today Jaipur. The palace, located in craggy hills, is a beautiful melange of Hindu and Mughal styles.



CITY PALACE

Located deep within the walled city, the City Palace Complex was conceived and built by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, the founder of Jaipur. A beautiful fusion of Mughal and Rajput architecture, the palace is still home to the last ruling royal family which lives in a private section of the palace.



JANTAR MANTAR

Now a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Jantar Mantar in Jaipur is considered to be the largest of the five astronomical observatories built by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, the founder of Jaipur. It contains sixteen geometric devices, designed to measure time, track celestial bodies and observe the orbits of the planets around the sun



NAHARGARH FORT

Nahargarh Fort sits proudly on a ridge of the Aravalli Hills, creating an impressive northern backdrop to the city of Jaipur. It was constructed during the reign of Jai Singh in 1734, and was later expanded in 1868. Nahargarh, which means abode of tigers, was a formidable barrier, defending Jaipur against attacking enemies.



ALBERT HALL MUSEUM

The building gets its name from The Victoria and Albert Museum in London, the inspiration for its design. The exquisitely built Albert Hall is housed in the centre of Ram Niwas Garden. Sir Swinton Jacob (who is also the mastermind behind many other palaces in Rajasthan)
















JAL MAHAL

One of the most wonderful sights in Jaipur is the beautiful Jal Mahal or Lake Palace. The light, sand coloured stone walls and the deep blue of the water make for a wonderful contrast. The palace appears to float in the centre of Man Sagar Lake.



JAIGARH FORT

About 15 kilometres from Jaipur, Jaigarh Fort was built by Sawai Jai Singh II sometime in the early 18th century amidst the arid, rocky and thorn-scrub covered hills. Despite its ancient construction, it still retains most of its imposing citadel appearance. Visitors can see the world's largest cannon – Jaiban, at the fort.



BIRLA TEMPLE

The Lakshmi-Narayan Temple, or the Birla Temple, as it is more popularly known as, is located at the base of Moti Dungari. Built on an elevated platform, this comparatively modern temple is built entirely of white marble and dominates the skyline of south Jaipur. The temple was commissioned and built by renowned Indian industrialists.



GOVIND DEVJI TEMPLE

The Krishna temple is a rare spire-less temple and houses the idol of Govind Devji that Sawai Jai Singh brought from Vrindavan. The deity, worshipped by the erstwhile royal family, is also revered by the the locals in the area.



HAWA MAHAL

Hawa Mahal, literally the Palace of Winds, was built in 1799 by the poet king Sawai Pratap Singh as a summer retreat for him and his family. It also served as a place where the ladies of the royal household could observe everyday life without being seen themselves
