MUMBAI INTERNATIONAL GRANDMASTER CHESS TOURNAMENT

INVITATION:

Aurionpro Solutions Limited, in collaboration with the Indian Chess School, warmly invites players from all FIDE-affiliated chess federations to participate in the 6th edition of the Aurionpro Mumbai International Grandmaster Chess Tournament.

ELIGIBILITY:

The tournament is open to all players with a Standard FIDE Rating as of 1st June 2025.

SYSTEM OF PLAY:

The championship will be conducted in accordance with the FIDE Laws of Chess and will be played on a 9-round Swiss League format. An accelerated pairing system will be implemented for the first three rounds.

TIME CONTROL & DEFAULT TIME:

Each player will have 90 minutes, with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move one. The default time is 30 minutes.

INVITATION:

Aurionpro Solutions Limited, in collaboration with the Indian Chess School, warmly invites players from all FIDE-affiliated chess federations to participate in the 6th edition of the Aurionpro Mumbai Junior International Chess Tournament.

ELIGIBILITY:

Open for all boys and girls under-13 years of age who are born on or after 01/01/2012. Participants must provide a valid birth certificate to confirm their eligibility. Foreign players may participate with a valid FIDE ID.

SYSTEM OF PLAY:

The championship will be conducted in accordance with the FIDE Laws of Chess and will follow a Nine round Swiss League format.

TIME CONTROL & DEFAULT TIME:

Each player will have 90 minutes, with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move one. The default time is 30 minutes.

NOTE FOR PRIZE MONEY:

NO PRIZE SHARING:

Prizes will not be shared, and each player will be eligible for only one higher prize.

TAX DEDUCTION:

As per Income Tax regulations of India, a 30% TDS (Tax Deducted at Source) will be applicable on the prize money awarded to players.

DOCUMENT SUBMISSION (INDIAN PLAYERS):

All Indian prize winners must submit a copy of their PAN card and AADHAR card.

DOCUMENT SUBMISSION (FOREIGN PLAYERS):

All foreign prize winners must submit a copy of their Passport and Visa.

PAYMENT PROCESS (INDIAN PLAYERS):

Prize money for Indian players will be transferred via bank transfer within 7 working days after submission of PAN details.

PAYMENT PROCESS (FOREIGN PLAYERS):

Prize money for foreign players will be processed via SWIFT transfer within 15 working days after submission of passport and visa details.

NOTE:

No requests for a waiver of the entry fee or waiver of the late fee will be entertained.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEE ON WITHDRAWAL:

The entry fee will be fully refunded if the withdrawal request is made on or before 12th June 2025. The refund process will commence within 7 days after the conclusion of the tournament.

PAIRING PROGRAM.

The tournament pairings will be generated using the FIDE-approved 'Swiss Manager' program.

RECOGNITION:

The championship is officially recognised and conducted under the auspices of the All India Chess Federation (AICF), Maharashtra Chess Association (MCA), and Mumbai City District Chess Association (MCDCA).

AICF REGISTRATION FOR 2025-2026:

All Indian players must be registered with AICF for the 2025-2026 season. Online registration can be completed at <u>www.aicf.in</u> by paying a fee of ₹300.00. Players must ensure their AICF registration is completed before submitting their tournament entry.

MCA REGISTRATION FOR MAHARASHTRA PLAYERS (2025-2026):

All players from Maharashtra must be registered with MCA for the 2025-2026 season. Online registration can be completed at <u>www.mcachess.i</u>n. Players must ensure their MCA registration is completed before submitting their tournament entry.

























REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS UNDER FIDE FLAG:

Players competing under the FIDE flag must have a licensed FIDE ID before registering for the tournament.

RIGHT TO ENTRY:

Indian Chess School reserves the right to reject any entry without providing any reason. In such cases, the entry fee will be refunded.

COMPETITION RULES:

TIE BREAKS:

- 1) Bucholz Cut 1
- 2) Bucholz
- 3) SB
- 4) Direct Encounter
- 5) Greater Number of Wins (including forfeit points)
- 6) Greater Number of Wins with Black

DEFAULT TIME:

Any player arriving at the chessboard 30 minutes after the scheduled start of the round shall forfeit the game. The default time is 30 minutes.

DRAW RULES:

Players cannot agree to a draw before 40 moves without the Arbiter's consent, as per the competition rules.

ARBITRATION OF PROTEST:

Any objection to the Chief Arbiter's decision must be submitted in writing, along with a protest fee of ₹2,000 (₹ Two Thousand Only), within 30 minutes of the incident. The fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

























FAIR PLAY REGULATIONS:

Players are strictly prohibited from carrying bags, mobile phones, or any other electronic devices into the playing arena. Dedicated deposit arrangements have been made for players to securely store their belongings before entering the tournament hall. The tournament will adhere to FIDE & AICF Fair Play regulations, and all players are required to respect and abide by these rules.

APPEALS COMMITTEE:

A five-member Appeals Committee, including two reserves, will be constituted from among the players (from coaches/officials in U13). The decision of this committee shall be final and binding on all participants.

INTERPRETATION:

For any interpretation of the rules or matters not covered in this tournament prospectus, the decision of the Tournament Director, Mr. Praful Zaveri, shall be final and binding on all participants. The Tournament Director reserves the right to make additions, deletions, or amendments to these rules. Any such changes will be displayed on the notice board.

ACCOMMODATION:

- 1. Invited foreign GMs will be provided free hotel accommodation on a twin-sharing basis.
- 2. Invited foreign IMs/WGMs/WIMs will be provided free hotel accommodation on a twin-sharing basis.
- 3. Invited Indian GMs and will be provided free hotel accommodation on a twin-sharing basis.
- 4. All foreign players with a rating above 2000 will be provided free hotel accommodation on a twin-sharing basis.
- 5. All other participants must arrange their own accommodation.

ABOUT THE VENUE:

The World Trade Centre, located in Cuffe Parade, is in close proximity to the iconic Gateway of India.

ACCESSIBILITY:

- The venue is easily accessible from two major railway stations:
 - o Churchgate and Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus (CST), which serve both local and longdistance trains.
 - o From these stations, visitors can reach the venue via taxi, shared cab services, or BEST buses.
- The Mumbai Metro Rail Corporation Ltd (MMRCL) has announced plans to launch Metro Line 3 (Aqua Line) - Phase 2, connecting Bandra Kurla Complex (BKC) to Cuffe Parade, by May 2025. The Cuffe Parade Metro Station will be within walking distance of the World Trade Centre.
- For air travellers, the venue is approximately 27 km from both the International and Domestic Terminals, accessible via the Western Express Highway.

WEATHER CONDITIONS IN MUMBAI IN JUNE & PRECAUTIONS FOR PLAYERS:

Mumbai experiences monsoon season in June, characterized by heavy rainfall, high humidity, and occasional thunderstorms. The temperatures typically range between 25°C to 32°C, with humid conditions making it feel warmer. Sudden downpours and waterlogging in some areas can cause travel delays.
