The UP Chess Sports Association, in collaboration with Delhi Public School, Sitapur Shiksha Sansthan, Resora, Sitapur, is organizing the UP State Women Chess Championship Senior 2025-26 from 25th & 27th March 2025.

Lodging and Fooding Details

Free lodging (dormitory) will be provided to **all participants** and **one official team manager** from each district team. For **others and accompanying persons**, a fee of **Rs. 600** per person will be charged.

Food will be provided by the venue partner on a prior booking and payment basis.

For those staying on the venue campus: Morning breakfast, lunch, evening tea with snacks, and dinner will be available for Rs. 600/- for the entire event. (Dinner on 24th March 2025 to evening tea with snacks on 27th March 2025)

For others: Lunch and evening tea with snacks will be available for Rs. 300/- for the entire event. (Lunch on 25th March 2025 to evening tea with snacks on 27th March 2025)

Prizes:

Cash prizes will be awarded in following manner: -

 1^{st} - 5000/-, 2^{nd} - 3000/-, 3^{rd} - 2000/-, 4^{th} - 1500/-, 5^{th} - 1100/-. 6^{th} to 9^{th} - 600/-

Entry Fee: -

For regular entry Rs.600/- and for special entry Rs.1000/-.

Players with a valid UPCSA ID from Sitapur & adjoining Districts (Barabanki, Bahraich, Kheri, Hardoi, and Lucknow) are allowed to participate as regular entries.

• Registration:

All participants must be registered with **UPCSA** for the year **2025-2026**.

UPCSA & District Registration Fee: Rs. 225/-

Please ensure that UPCSA registration is completed to participate in the event.

- For Players with Inactive UPCSA IDs or New IDs:
 - Players whose **UPCSA ID** for **2024-25** is not active or who have created a new ID can activate their ID on or after **March 1, 2025**. Their membership will remain active until **March 31, 2026 (13 Months).**
- For players whose ID is active until March 31, 2025, the membership payment can be made under "Other Payment," and their ID will be activated for 2025-26 in the first week of April 2025.

<u>Representation</u>: - First four selected players will represent UP State in National Senior Women Chess Championship 2025-26.

Last Date of Entry:

Please note that the entry fee structure is valid until **20**th **March 2025**. After this date, a late fee of Rs. 200/- per player will be levied. No entries will be accepted after **23**rd **March 2025** (up to 17:00 hrs.).

Tournament System: -

- i. The tournament will be played in **maximum of 7** rounds under the Swiss System of league governed by latest FIDE rules for chess.
- ii. Each session will be of 60 minutes + 30 seconds increment from the first move.
- iii. FIDE Tie break Rule should be applicable.
- iv. Protest if any, can be made within 15 minutes from the completion of the games along with a protest fee of Rs.2000/ which is refundable if protest is upheld.
- v. The decision of Appeals committee will be final and binding to all.

ELIGIBILITY: -

- i. Four Players from every affiliated District/Unit of UPCSA (recommended by district secretary on district letter head). All the arrears of affiliation fee including current year (2024-25) and other dues (if any) must be cleared by the concerned District/Unit prior to submission of entries. District/Units will not be allowed if arrears are not cleared. Players participating from district without association have to pay Rs. 1000/- entry fees for the championship.
- ii. If any affiliated unit fails to pay their affiliation fee by April 30 of each financial year, their affiliation with UPCSA will be considered terminated. In cases of valid reasons for delay, the UPCSA Executive Committee may review the situation if the concerned unit applies by 30th May. If no

application is submitted by the deadline, the unit will be required to go through the **re-registration process** on **UPCSA's** terms, **only if the UPCSA Executive Committee grants permission** to do so in order to regain affiliation.

- iii. Top two players from the previous UP State U-7, U-9, U-11, U-13, & U-17 Girls Chess Championship and top 4 players from the previous UP State Senior Women Chess Championship, UP State U-15 & U-19 Girls Chess Championship as regular entry.
- iv. Two players who could not participated in their District tournament, as may be nominated by the Hon. Gen. Secretary of UPCSA following the recommendation of concerned District Secretary as regular entry.
