Note to District Chess Associations:

Advise all your district players to take part in this State Championship.

All entries, be it regular or special, should be routed through the respective district chess association on or before 24.05.2025.

No entry will be entertained after 24.05.2025.

While sending the entries, District Chess Associations should certify that the players have been duly selected from the selection/District Chess Championship giving details of venue and date. If such a certificate is not sent, all their entries will be treated as special entries.

Entries/Entry fee

All entries (normal or special) should be paid only through online portal

(https://registration.tamilchess.com/online-entry/)

along with the copy of date of birth certificate for verification. Payments made through other modes will not be accepted. Player'sparticipation will be accepted only after obtaining the recommendations from their concerned district chess association. The entryfee, once paid, shall not be refunded if the withdrawal from the championship is done after the publication of the first-round pairings.

Eligibility: Subject to Age Stipulation

- Only Indian nationals are eligible to participate.
- Every affiliated District Chess Association/Special Unit of TNSCA is entitled to field four entries.
- The TNSCA General Secretary can nominate one entry.
- The top four rankers from Tamil Nadu State Open Chess Championship 2024 held at Coimbatore.
- The championship of Tamil Nadu State Under 19 Open Chess Championship 2024 held at Krishnagiri.
- The host Virudhunagar DCA (Virudhunagar District Chess Association) is entitled to field one additional entry.
- Any player who pays the prescribed entry fee: Rs.2000/- may be considered for participation with recommendation of the respective District Chess Association.
- In the event of odd entry, the host Virudhunagar DCA is entitled add one more entry to make total number as
 even in each category.
- Those who have qualified to represent the country in official FIDE events.
- Any current national champion in any category.

- In addition to above the following districts can field additional entries by virtue of three medal winners (Gold, Silver and Bronze) secured by their players in the last 74th Tamil Nadu State Open Chess Championship 2024 held at Coimbatore.
- Open: Gold (3) Coimbatore, Silver (2) Chengalpattu & Bronze (1) Chennai.
- All GMs, WGMs, IMs and WIMs are eligible to play as seeded players in the eligible category.

RULES & REGULTIONS

Age Eligibility

Only Tamil Nadu players can participate in this championship. Other country passport holders shall not be allowed to participate in the State Chess Championship.

Boarding and Lodging

Lodging will be provided to seeded/selected players and one manager per team at college hostel campus as first preference. For special entry players rooms are subject to availability. Only one accompanying person is allowed. (with common rest room). Players are requested to bring their own beddings.

Seeded/Selected players are requested to confirm the need of accommodation while sending the entry. Male & female will be provided separate accommodations irrespective of age. Canteen facilities are available on payment basis at the college premises itself.

Boarding charges from the morning of 1st June to lunch of 5th June Rs. 850/- per person. Booking has to be done by filling up the g-form given below. G-form link https://docs.google.com/forms/d/1Jt1ZJp6oGdGICT6wE7sBFJzph_aKoijFy6nfuWI-ops/edit for Boarding Rs.850/- (CASH ONLY. NO GPAY) will be collected on spot during accommodation

AICF Player Registration

AICF player registration is compulsory for all players. AICF player registration fee is Rs.300/- for the year 2025-2026. AICF player registrations will be accepted only through online. Players' registration should be done well before the start of the event (Championship).

For fresh AICF registration, players are requested to keep their scanned passport size photograph and birth certificate and a valid email address (unique) not used by any other person/player for AICF, ready before the registration process.

Note: Only passport size (less than 1 MB) photographs in jpeg format should be uploaded.

TNSCA Player registration

TNSCA player registration is compulsory for all Tamil Nadu players. TNSCA player registration fee is Rs.150/- for the year 2025-2026. Player registration should be done well before the start of event (Tournament). New entrants to the field of chess are informed that TNSCA player registration is mandatory and it should be done well before participating in any tournament. For fresh TNSCA registration, players are requested to keep their scanned passport size photograph and birth certificate and a valid email address ready before the registration process.

Note: Only passport size (less than 1 MB) photographs in jpeg format should be uploaded.

Virudhunagar DCA player registration

Virudhunagar District Chess Association player registration is compulsory for Virudhunagar district players only. The fee for the year 2025-2026 is Rs.50/- only has to paid only through https://pages.razorpay.com/vdca

Rules: FIDE rules in force shall apply.

System of Play: The Tournament shall be conducted on a nine rounds Swiss system.

Time Control:

90 minutes each plus 30 seconds increment/move from move number one.

Default Time:

Default time is 15 minutes. Players have to be at the boards within 15 minutes from the start of the round.

Tie-break: Buchholz Cut 1, Buchholz, Sonneborn Berger, Direct Encounter, number of wins (forfeit included) and greater number of wins by black tie-break rules will be applied. In case of tie, prizes will not be shared.

Chess Clocks

Each district association is requested to provide at least two chess clocks for every four players.

Appeals Committee

An Appeals Committee comprising of five members plus two reserves will be formed at the managers' meeting. All the members and reserves shall be from different districts. No member of the committee can vote on dispute in which a player from his own district is involved and in such case(s), the reserve member will take his place. The decision of the appeals committee is final and binding on all players concerned.

Tournament Committee

The tournament committee consisting of the General Secretary, TNSCA or his representative, the host Virudhunagar DCA Secretary or his representative and representative from another district to be nominated by the TNSCA shall decide on all emergency matters.

Protest

Protest, if any against the decision of the Chief arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.1000/- within 15 minutes of the completion of the game. The decisions of the appeals committee shall be final and binding on all concerned. The protest fee is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

Withdrawals: A player may withdraw from the tournament at any stage after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.

Arrears: The players belonging to districts which are in arrears to TNSCA will not be allowed to take part.

Rights of Admission

The AICF/TNSCA/organizer Sivakasi Chess Club reserve the rights of admission to the venue and lodging place.

Wrist watches & Electronic Devises

AICF has banned the wrist watches & electronic devises while playing in FIDE rated events. Possession of any electronic devise or wrist watch during the game will lead to loss of the game.

Silence in the Tournament Hall

Strict silence must be observed in the tournament hall. Players who have finished their games shall not remain in the tournament hall. Players shall not analyse the game in the tournament hall.

- 1. Parents and accompanying persons are not allowed inside the tournament hall at all times.
- 2. Organizers take all the measures for safe championship environment. However, in case any untoward situation arises, the players will not ask damages from the organizers/Tamil Nadu State Chess Association.
- 3. Due to any unforeseen scenario, if the event needs to be cancelled, then TNSCA's obligation is limited to refunding the entry fee paid by the players.
- 4. By enrolling for the events, the players abide by all the terms and conditions of the championship for participation.




