Rules & Regulations

- KSCA Registration for the year 2025-2026 is compulsory. (<https://karnatakachess.com/player-registration>)
- Only Indian Nationals and Karnataka residents are eligible to participate in this event. PIO and OCI card holders are not eligible.
- Birth Certificate/Passport should be produced to the arbiter if required.
- This tournament will be played on a Swiss League basis under the latest FIDE rules.
- Duration: 60 minutes + 30 seconds increment from move 1.
- In case of tie, the latest FIDE rules will be applied. Prizes will not be shared.
- Top 4 players of this Championship will represent Karnataka in the forthcoming National Women's Chess Championship.
- Any player who arrives at the chess board after 15 minutes, from the start of the session, shall lose the game. Thus, the default time is 15 minutes.
- Draw Agreement: Players shall not agree for a draw without the consent of the arbiter, before each player makes 30 moves.
- Protests, if any, against the decision of the chief arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of ₹1000/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident to the Appeals Committee. The protest fee shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
- An Appeals Committee consisting of 5 members shall be formed at the Players' Meeting. The decision of the Appeals Committee is final and binding on all the players.
- All electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the playing hall.
- A player may withdraw at any stage of the event, after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.
- One player will get one higher prize only. A player must score at least half point to get a prize.
- E-Certificate will be given to all the players.
- No spot entries.
- No refund/transfer of entry fees incase of withdrawl or no show.
- Players have to make their own arrangements for food and stay.
- Water will be provided. Please bring your own water bottles.
