#### 1. Invitation:

Nanded District chess & Rapid chess Association Nanded has the honour to invite all Chess players from the State of Maharashtra to participate in the "h2e Power Systems Maharashtra State Selection Under-19 Open and Girls Chess Championship 2025".

#### 2. Recognition:

The championship is held under the auspices of the MCA, AICF & FIDE. The said championship is organized by "Nanded District chess & Rapid chess Association Nanded and Saksham Chess Academy, Nanded" and will serve as the selection event for the National Under 19 Chess Championship 2025.

#### 3. Eligibility Criteria:

- Only the players who fulfil the following conditions are eligible to play in the said chess championship.
- Born on and after 1st January 2006.
- All entries should be strictly routed through the respective District Chess Associations affiliated with MCA.



Each district association is entitled to field 4 players in the Open & 4 in Girls in each category. Additional entries for last year's medal winners are as follows.

• Under 19 Girls : Pune – 3 ; Kolhapur – 3

• Under 19 Open: Ahilyanagar – 3; Pune – 3

• 'Selected Player' means the player selected from the respective District Selection Events. Besides the above, the District Associations may enter an unlimited number of players as a Donor Entry.

#### 4. Selection of Maharashtra Team:

The top 4 boys and Top 4 girls will be selected to represent Maharashtra State in the forthcoming National Chess Championship for the Same Age Group. Players participating in this championship will only be allowed to participate in National Chess Championship.

- Participation in this championship is compulsory if any player wishes to take part in National Under-19 Chess Championship, 2025
- If any player wishes to skip the state selection championships and directly take part in national championships then he/she will have to pay a non refundable privilege fee of Rs. 3,500 to MCA. Privilege fee will not be collected if the player has participated in any one of the state selection championships prior to playing in the national championship in which he/she desires to take part in. Any decision taken by the Hon. Gen. Secretary of Maharashtra Chess Association regarding entry under the privilege fee scheme will be treated as final.

#### 5. Date of Birth Certificates:

- Each participant must produce a valid certificate to prove his/her age. School ID card/Aadhar Card won't be accepted as DOB proof. Certificates should preferably be from the Panchayat, Municipality or Corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without date of birth certificates will not be allowed to participate.
- The date of birth certificates registered within one year of the birth of the child alone will be recognized and allowed to participate.
- If any doubt arises about the claimed age of a player, the Tournament Committee has the right to refer the player during the championship for a due evaluation of age by competent medical experts. A player if declared over age by such experts shall not continue in the championship and the matter shall be reported to AICF. Protest about the age of players may be made to the Chief Arbiter in writing along with a fee of 5000/- per player. This will not be refunded. No protest about over age of a player will be entertained after 2nd round of the championship.

#### 9. System of Play:

- The tournament will be played with 8 rounds Swiss system. The format may be changed to emergency cases at the discretion of the Chief Arbiter & Tournament Director with prior approval from MCA & AICF.
- The time control will be 60 minutes + 30 seconds increment from move 1. Default time: 15 min.

#### 11. Electronic Devices:

No electronic devices, mobile phones, and wristwatches are allowed in the playing venue. If a player is caught with any of these then a loss will be given in his/her game straightaway.

#### 12. Appeals:

The Chief Arbiter Decision will be final & binding to all. In case of any discrepancy, the matter will be handed over to the Appeals Committee which will be formed during the Players' meeting before the start of the First Round.

#### 13. Accommodation:

- The selected players will be given free dormitory sharing or rooms as accommodation by the organizers at Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University, Nanded Sports Hostel.

  Accommodation will be closed 9th Sept. 2025.
- Team managers/ Parents will not be provided with free accommodation.




