1. No. of round : Number of rounds depend on no. of participants.

Arrival: 13th October **Reporting Time:** 09 : 00 AM. **First round:** 10 : 00 AM

2. Eligibility for Participation:

All players registered with All Bihar Chess Associations are eligible to participate in the Championship. The District Chess Associations have the right of sending any number of entries. Only Bihar (Indian nationals) players are eligible to participate in this championship. However, He / She must be born on or after 1 January ,2006

3. Entries & entry fee:

Entry fee: **RS. 500/- (Five hundred only)**

4. Last date of entry:

No entry will be accepted after **10th October 2025** (up to 18:00 hrs.).

5. Prizes: 50,000/- Cash prizes

Open: 1.6500 , 2.4500 , 3.3500 , 4.2500 , 5.2000 , 6. 1500 , 7. 1500, 8.1000, 9. 1000, 10. 1000

Girls: 1.6500 , 2.4500 , 3.3500 , 4.2500 , 5.2000 , 6. 1500 , 7. 1500, 8.1000, 9. 1000, 10. 1000

Trophies & Medals will be given to all prize winners . However, certificate of participation will be given to all the participants .

6. System of Play: The Championship will be played under FIDE Laws of Chess .

7. Default Time: Default timing for arriving to the chess board is 15 Minutes. Those who arrive at the board 15 minutes after the start of the game will be declared lost.

8. Time Control: The rate of play shall be **60** minutes with an increment of **30** seconds per move from move number one.

9. Tie-Break: Following is the order of Tie-Break:

- (a) Buchholz Cut1
- (b) Buchholz
- (c) Sonneborn Berger
- (d) Direct encounter
- (e) The greater number of wins (forfeit included)
- (f) Number of wins with black pieces

In case of tie, cash prizes will not be shared.

10. Selection: Top four players from each group will be selected to represent Bihar in National U-19 Chess Championship.

11. Protest: Protests, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.1000/-within one hour of the occurrence of the incident. The amount shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

12. ABCA Registration: All participants in the State Championship should be registered with ABCA for the year 2025 - 2026. Online registration is available on the website.

Before the start of the championship all the players must be registered with ABCA for the year 2025-2026. No entry will be accepted without Player's Registration for 2025-2026.

13. Electronic Devices: All electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall.

If a player is found to possess a mobile (switched on/off)/wristwatch, either on the person or in a separate bag, he will be declared as lost. Player wearing any kind of watch during the game will also be declared lost.

15. Accommodation:
