

RULES & REGULATIONS



- Lodging: Outstation players should make their own lodging arrangements.
- Entry Fees: Entry Fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- System of Play: 9 Rounds of Swiss System.
- Time Control: 60 minutes + 30 seconds increment from move 1.
- Default Time: 15 minutes. Players have to be present at the boards within 15 minutes of the start of the round.
- Tie Break: 1. Buchholz Cut 1, 2. Buchholz 3. Sonneborn Berger, 4. Direct Encounter 5. Greater Number of Victories (including Forfeit), 6. Number of Wins with Black. In case of tie, prizes will not be shared.
- Protests: Protests if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with protest fee of Rs.1,000/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident to the appeals committee. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
- Appeals Committee: Before the commencement of the Tournament, appeals committee with 5 members will be formed from the senior participants present at the players meeting. All the members will be from different state/district. The appeals committee decisions will be final and binding on all players concerned.
- Withdrawal: A player may withdraw at any stage of the event after informing the chief arbiter in writing.
- Watches and Mobiles: All the Wrist Watches and Mobile phones are strictly not allowed while playing the event.
 - Wrist watches are not to be weared and the mobile phones are to be kept in a separate bag in a switched off mode.
 - Violating the above rule will result in loss of the game.
- Prizes and Certificates: Prizes will not be given in advance. Hence, players are requested to plan their departure after 7:30PM.
 - Age category prizes are based on the year of Birth.
- AICF & KSCA Registrations: AICF and KSCA registration for the year 2025-26 is compulsory for all the players and it has to be done before the first round of pairing. AICF registration can be done at https://prs.aicf.in/ and KSCA registration can be done at https://karnatakachess.com/player-registration.
