


Scholarships

We are starting two scholarships this year.

The first will be in the name of Madhya Pradesh's first National player, Late R. Satyamurti.

This scholarship, worth ₹25,000, will be awarded to the Best Under 12 player of the event through the HelpChess Foundation.



The second scholarship will be in the name of Late IA Jitendra Choudhary, awarded to the Best Under-10 player of the event. This scholarship, also worth ₹25,000 will be provided through the HelpChess Foundation.



Tiebreak for the Scholarship:

If two or more players tie for a scholarship, the top two in the final ranking will play two blitz tiebreak games. In case the score is 1–1, an Armageddon game will be played to decide the winner.

The scholarship amount of ₹25,000 must be used exclusively for chess training, purchase of chess material, payment of entry fees, and travel to tournaments.

AICF player registration is compulsory for all Indian players.

Appeals Committee:

An appeals Committee will be formed during the technical meeting.

a. Protests:

Protests, if any against the decision of the arbiter shall be made in – writing with a protest fee Rs. 1000/- (RS. One thousand only) within 15 minutes of the incident. The Protest fee is refundable only if protest is upheld. The decision of the appeals committee on all protest shall be final and binding.

 AICF player registration fee Rs. 300/- for the year 2025 2026 has to be paid
 well before the start of tournament. It will be accepted only through online.

Interpretation:

For interpretation of the rules and deciding any point not covered by the rules, the decision of the tournament committee shall be final and binding.

Withdrawals:

A player may withdraw at any stage of the event, after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.

One player will be given one (higher) prize only.

The tournament will be conducted as per the latest FIDE Laws of Chess

Players are not allowed to use any type of wrist watch, mobile, or any such electronic device in the playing area.

For the category prize:

the organizer may ask the players for their date of birth proof, and by registering for the tournament players are abide to present the Date of Birth Proof for the given tournament.

Organizer has the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason.

Organizing committee is not responsible for any discomfort or any other problems like transportation etc for those are staying at other hotel. Participants need to reach to the tournament venue at due course of time as mentioned above in this brochure. Sardinia World Chess Festival is our international tournament partner.
