

Rules & Regulations:

- This Championship will be played under FIDE'S Laws of Chess and the Swiss System.
- 2. **Protest:** Protest if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of ₹1,000/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is up held.
- 3. **Appeals Committee:** Before the commencement of the tournament, a five member appeals committees shall be formed by the Tournament organizers.
 - A) All the members and reserves shall be from different relative categories.
 - B) No member of the Committee can vote on a dispute in which a player from his own Relative is involved and, in such case(s), the reserve members shall take his place in the committee.
- 4. **Tournament Organizing Committee:** The organizers will form a tournament organizing committee for the smooth conduct of the District Championship.
- 5. **Interpretation:** For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all.
- 6. The organizer has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without notice. However, such changes or inclusion will be subject to Committee Clearance. Such changes will however, be displayed in the tournament hall.
- 7. **Electronic Devices:** All electronic items, including wrist watches (all types of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall. Those who have mobile phones or wearing watches during their play will be declared lost.
- 8. **Fair Play and Anti-Cheating Measures:** Players are strictly required to adhere to the highest standards of fair play and sportsmanship throughout the tournament. Any breach of these principles, including but not limited to the use of unauthorized electronic devices, receiving external assistance, or any manipulation of game results, will lead to immediate disqualification and forfeiture of all prizes. The Tournament Organizing Committee will enforce anti-cheating measures, including random electronic device checks and personal inspections, to ensure fair play.
- 9. A player can withdraw at any stage of the event after informing Chief arbiter in writing.
- 10. The Organizer will have the right to accept/reject any entry without assigning any reason.


