Tournament rules:

- **System of play:** the tournament will be conducted as per fide laws of chess and fide Swiss system with 8 rounds.
- **Default time (walk over time)** the default time will be 10 minutes
- **Tie break:** in case of a tie, the latest fide rules shall come in to effect.
- **Draw agreement:** players shall not agree for a draw without the consent of the arbiter, before each player makes 30 moves
- **Electronic devices:** - all electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall.
- **Chief arbiter's decision** will be final binding any or all kinds of disputes.
- **All players must produce dob certificates** registered within a year of birth whenever
- **Asked**
- **We don't provide any refreshment** so players need to do the needful.
- **Due to any unforeseen scenario**, if the event needs to be cancelled, then District Chess Association S.A.S. Nagar obligation is limited to refunding the entry fee paid by the players.
- **Protest:** protest, if any, against the decision of the chief arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of rs.3000/- within 30 minutes after the completion of the concerned
- **Game.** The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
- **Appeals committee:** before the commencement of the tournament, a five- member appeals
- **Committee** shall be formed by the PSCA/organizers. All the members and reserves shall be from different districts. No member of the committee can vote on a dispute in which a player from his own district is involved and, in such case(s) the reserve member(s) shall take his place in the committee.
- **Time control** 25 min + 10 sec increment from move 1

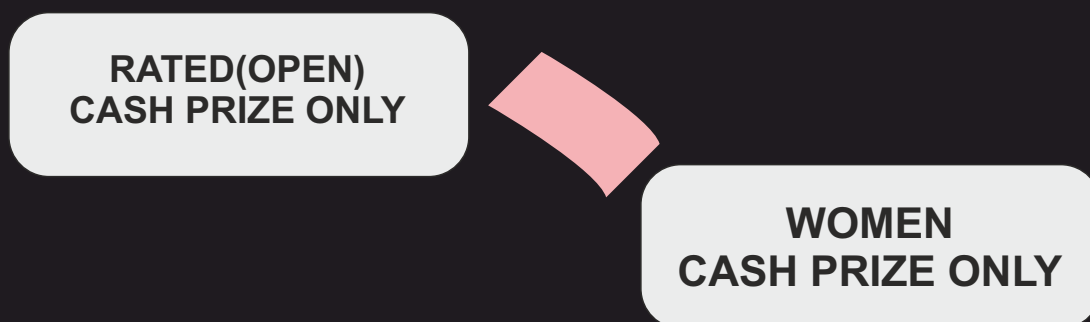
