IMPORTANT NOTE & ELIGIBILITY

ELIGIBILITY

All Indian players (Rated & Unrated) are eligible to participate.
Foreign players must possess a valid FIDE ID under their respective federation or FIDE flag.
The Organising Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason.

MANDATORY AICF REGISTRATION (2025–26)

Participation is subject to valid AICF registration.



NEW REGISTRATION



RENEWAL

Players must complete AICF registration/renewal prior to participation.
Failure to comply will result in ineligibility.

PRIZE REGULATIONS

Prize money will not be shared.
A player is entitled to only one higher prize.
Income Tax will be deducted as per the Indian Income Tax Act and applicable rules.
Players in Age Categories are eligible only for prizes in their respective age category and not for higher age category prizes.
Best Female Prizes will be awarded only to female participants aged 15 years and above.

Mary Cherian Memorial is a public event that will be photographed and filmed. Players and spectators images may be photographed at any time during the event. Your participation in the tournament will be accepted as your consent and acknowledgment that the organizing team has the right to broadcast your image in connection with our event and promotions related to the event, through our social media channels and any other media associated with the event.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR AICF

(FOR NEW PLAYERS)

All Indian players must have a valid AICF Registration (2025–26) to participate in this FIDE Rated Tournament.

FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW CAREFULLY:

Step-by-Step Guide for New Registration

- 1 Visit the Official AICF Portal**
 - <https://prs.aicf.in/new-register>
- 2 Create Player Profile**
 - Enter player's full name (as per official ID)
 - Date of Birth
 - Gender
 - Select your State Association
 - Fill Parent/Guardian details (for minors)
 - Provide valid mobile number & email ID
- 3 Upload Required Documents**
 - Passport size photograph
 - Date of Birth proof (Birth Certificate / Passport / Aadhaar)
 - Identity proof
 - Upload clear and properly scanned documents.
- 4 Complete Online Payment**
 - Pay the registration fee through the official portal.
 - Registration is valid for the financial year 2025–26.
- 5 Approval & AICF ID Generation**
 - The application will be verified by the AICF.
 - Once approved, the new player (your child) will receive a unique AICF ID, which is mandatory for participating in rated tournaments in India.



IMPORTANT NOTICE

- Apply at least one week in advance before the tournament.
- Players without valid AICF registration will not be paired.
- Early registration prevents last-minute technical or approval delays.

RULES & REGULATIONS

This tournament will be conducted strictly in accordance with international standards to ensure fairness, transparency, and professional conduct.

SYSTEM OF PLAY

- The event will be conducted as per the Laws of Chess laid down by FIDE.
- Format: FIDE Swiss System
- Total Rounds: 09 Rounds

TIME CONTROL

- 25 Minutes + 10 Seconds increment per move (from move 1)
- Default Time (Walkover Time): 15 minutes
- A player arriving more than 15 minutes late from the start of the round will lose the game by default.

REPORTING TIME

- 2nd May 2026 – 08:30 AM
- All players must complete reporting and verification procedures before the Players' Meet.

AICF REGISTRATION

- All Indian players must have valid AICF Registration (2025–26) before participation.
- Players without valid registration will not be paired.

TIE-BREAK REGULATIONS

- Tie-breaks will be applied as per the latest AICF guidelines.
- In case of further clarification, the latest FIDE rules shall prevail.
- Cash prizes will not be shared under any circumstances.

PROTESTS & APPEALS

- Any protest against the decision of the Chief Arbiter must be submitted in writing within 15 minutes of the incident.
- A protest fee of ₹2000 must accompany the appeal.
- The fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
- A 5-member Appeals Committee will be formed before the commencement of the tournament.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

- All electronic devices, including mobile phones and all types of wrist watches, are strictly prohibited inside the playing arena.
- Violation may lead to penalties as per FIDE regulations.

WITHDRAWALS

- A player wishing to withdraw must inform the Chief Arbiter.
- If a player misses a round without prior intimation, it will be treated as withdrawal and the player will be removed from subsequent pairings.

DISCIPLINE

- Players and parents are expected to maintain professional decorum.
- Any misconduct, disturbance, or violation of tournament discipline may result in exclusion from the event.

TRAVEL GUIDE

VENUE: SHRI RAM COLLEGE OF COMMERCE (SRCC), NORTH CAMPUS, DELHI

The venue is centrally located in Delhi University's North Campus with strong connectivity across all major transport hubs.

NEAREST AIRPORT

- Indira Gandhi International Airport
- Distance: 27 km
- Estimated Travel Time: 50–70 minutes (traffic dependent)

NEAREST RAILWAY STATIONS

- New Delhi Railway Station
- Distance: 8 km
- Estimated Travel Time: 25–35 minutes
- Both stations are well connected via metro, auto-rickshaw, and cab services.
- Old Delhi Railway Station
- Distance: 7 km
- Estimated Travel Time: 20–30 minutes

NEARBY METRO STATIONS

- Vishwavidyalaya Metro Station (Yellow Line)
- Distance: Approx. 1 km
- Travel Time: 5–7 minutes by auto
- Both stations are well connected via metro, auto-rickshaw, and cab services.
- GTB Nagar Metro Station
- Distance: Approx. 1.5 km
- Travel Time: 5–7 minutes by auto

NEARBY BUS TERMINAL

- ISBT Kashmere Gate
- Distance: Approx. 5 km
- Travel Time: 15–20 minutes

TRAVEL RECOMMENDATION

- Metro is the most reliable option during peak hours.
- Players are advised to plan arrival at least 30–45 minutes early, especially on Day 1.
- App-based cabs are easily accessible from all major transport points.

FOR NEW PARENTS AND PLAYERS

WHAT IS A FIDE RATING & HOW DOES YOUR CHILD GET ONE?

- When your child enters competitive chess, the most important milestone is earning an international rating.
- **FIDE (World Chess Federation)** is the global governing body of chess. It maintains the official international rating system that ranks players worldwide based on their tournament performance.
- A **FIDE Rating** is a numerical score that reflects a player's competitive strength. It is updated monthly and serves as the global benchmark for serious tournament players. This rating allows children to participate in National Tournament, International events, and higher-level competitions.

HOW DOES A CHILD GET A FIDE RATING?

Register with AICF (India's national federation)

- This is mandatory before playing any FIDE Rated Tournament in India.

Participate in a FIDE Rated Tournament

- The tournament must be officially registered, conducted under international rules, and supervised by certified arbiters.

Score Against Rated Players

- To receive an initial rating, a player must score points against rated opponents and meet the minimum performance requirements set by FIDE (currently equivalent to 1400 performance level).

Rating Publication

- Once eligibility criteria are fulfilled, the tournament results are submitted to FIDE. The player's rating is then published in the official monthly rating list.

WHAT IS A FIDE RATED TOURNAMENT?

A FIDE Rated Tournament is an officially approved event where:

- Games follow international laws of chess
- Results impact international ratings
- Players compete against rated opposition
- Professional tournament standards are maintained

A FIDE rating is more than just a number.

- It is the beginning of your child's international chess journey – a measurable step into structured, competitive excellence.
