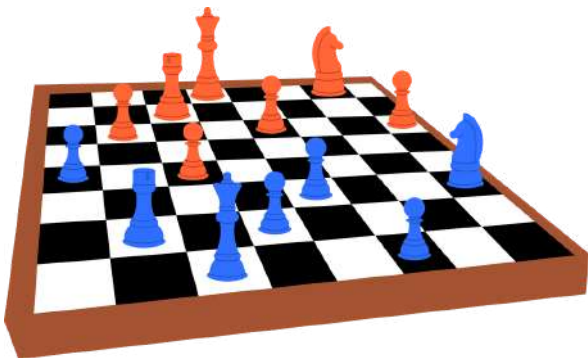

RULES & REGULATION

System of Play: The Tournament will be conducted as per FIDE laws of Chess & FIDE Swiss system.

Number of rounds will depend on number of entries. Round timings will be declared in players meeting depending on number of rounds.

Time Control: 15minutes + 5 seconds increment from move one.

Default Time: Default time for arriving to the chessboard is 15 minutes.

Electronic Devices: Any Electronic Devices including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall.

Tie-break: Following is the order of tie-break:

(a) Buchholz Cut1, (b) Buchholz, (c) Sonneborn Berger, (d) Direct encounter, (e) The greater number of wins (forfeit included), (f) Greater Number of wins with Black.

Withdrawal: In the event of absence to any round without prior information to the CHIEF ARBITER in writing the Player's name will be removed from the pairing for further rounds.

Protest: Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a Protest fee of Rs. 1000/- within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded, if the appeal is upheld.

Disqualification: No participant will leave the venue before the Prize Distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter. The participants disregarding the rule will be suspended for one year.

Appeals Committee: Before the commencement of the championship, a five- member Appeals Committee shall be formed by the organizers. All the members and reserves shall be from the different units. No member of the committee can vote on dispute in which a player from his own district is involved and in such case the reserves shall take his place in the committee.

Interpretation: On any point not covered under these rules, the decision of the Championship Committee shall be final and binding on all. The Championship Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without prior notice. Such changes will, however be displayed in the tournament hall.

Prize money will be transferred via online mode and in INR (Indian National Rupee) only

There will be tax deductions of foreign players' prize money as per the Govt. guidelines. Indian Income Tax Act and Rules will be applicable.

Note: - Organizer reserves the right to accept or reject any Entry without assigning the reason at any moment.
