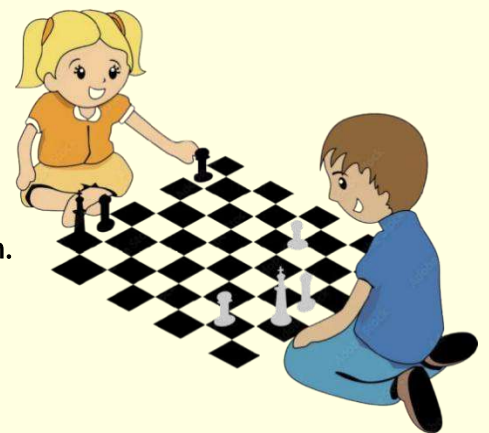

## RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Age Limit:** Players should be born on or after 01.01.2017.
- 2. Age Proof:** Each participant must produce a valid birth certificate to prove his/ her age. Certificates from school will not be accepted. Certificates should preferably be from the Panchayat, Municipality or Corporation obtained soon after birth.
- 3. Birth Certificate:** The date of birth certificates registered within one year of the birth of the player alone will be recognized and allowed to participate. No district association shall recommend any player who doesn't come under the above criteria.
- 4. Eligibility:** a) Any player residing in West Bengal and born on or after 01 January 2017 is eligible to participate, subject to approval from the concerned District Chess Association.  
b) Each affiliated District Chess Association is entitled to nominate a maximum of four (4) players (2 Open and 2 Girls). These nominated players will be eligible for a 50% refund of the entry fee.
- 5. Selection:** Top 2 players(both open & girls) will be selected for participating in the forthcoming National Under-9 open & Girls chess Championship.
- 6. System of Play:** The Championship will be played under FIDE Laws of Chess and the Swiss system. Maximum (8) eight rounds of game shall be played. Standard rating will be considered in the Tournament.
- 7. Grace period:** A maximum grace period of 30 minutes from the scheduled start of the round will be allowed. A player who fails to arrive within this time may be declared lost by walkover.
- 8. Time Control:** The rate of play shall be 90 minutes with an increment of 30 seconds per move from move number one.



**9. Tie Break:** In case of a tie, the final ranking shall be determined by the following tie-break system, in order:

- i) Buchholz Cut-1
- ii) Buchholz
- iii) Sonneborn-Berger
- iv) Direct Encounter
- v) Greater Number of Wins (including forfeits)



**10. Protest:** Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of ₹1,000/- by Cash within 10 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

**11. Appeals Committee:** Before the commencement of the tournament, a three-member appeals committee shall be formed by the SBDS/ organizers.

**12. Interpretation:** For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all. The Tournament Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules. However, such changes or inclusion will be subject to SBDS clearance. Such changes will, however, be displayed in the tournament hall.

**13. Withdrawal:** If any player absents himself in any round without written intimation to the Chief Arbiter, he/ she will be treated as withdrawn himself/ herself.

**14. Disqualification:** No participant will leave the venue before the Prize Distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter.

**15. Registration of Players:** All participants must have valid AICF and SBDS registrations for the year 2026–2027 on or before 27.05.2026.

**16. Electronic Devices:** All electronic devices including wrist watches (all types of watches) are not allowed inside the tournament hall.

**17. Accommodation:** Outstation players will have to arrange their own accommodations.

**18. ENTRY FEE:** ₹1,200/- (entry fees once paid will not be refunded)

**19. LAST DATE OF ENTRY:** 24-05-2026 (upto 6-00 pm)

**20.** Any entry form with incomplete or incorrect information will be rejected without notice.

Birth certificate should be uploaded in the entry form (Mandatory) for those who do not have any FIDE ID.**
