# RULES & REGULATIONS



## ELIGIBILITY:

This Championship is open to all residents of West Bengal only. Seeded players (those eligible to participate directly in the National Open Chess Championship) will not be permitted to participate in this championship.



## ENTRIES/ENTRY FEE:

Only online entries are accepted. However, SBDS reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason. Title players (GM/WGM/IM/WIM) are not allowed to play. Two representatives from each affiliated District Chess Association will receive a 50% refund after depositing the full entry fee.



## SYSTEM OF PLAY:

The Championship will be conducted under FIDE Laws of Chess using the Swiss System. A total of nine (9) rounds will be played.



## DEFAULT TIME:

The default time for arrival at the chessboard is 30 minutes.



## TIME CONTROL:

The rate of play shall be 90 minutes with an increment of 30 seconds per move from move number one.



## TIE-BREAKS:

The order of tie-breaks will be as follows: a) Buchholz b) Buchholz Cut 1 c) Sonneborn-Berger d) Direct Encounter e) Number of Wins (Forfeit wins will not be counted); In case of a tie, cash prizes will be shared.



## PROTEST:

Any protest against the decision of the Chief Arbiter must be submitted in writing within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident, along with a protest fee of Rs. 1500/- in cash. The fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.



## APPEALS COMMITTEE:

A three-member Appeals Committee (from the participating players) will be formed by the SBDS/organizers before the commencement of the tournament.



## CERTIFICATES:

The top 25 players will receive Merit Certificates, and all participants will receive e-Participation Certificates.

# RULES & REGULATIONS



## PRIZE DISTRIBUTION CEREMONY:

All prize winners must attend the ceremony to receive their prizes personally; otherwise, prizes/prize money will be forfeited.



## SELECTION:

The top four ranked players will represent West Bengal in the National Senior Open Chess Championship 2026.



## INTERPRETATION:

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to make any additions or alterations to these rules. All such changes or inclusions will be subject to SBDS clearance and will be displayed in the tournament hall.



## WITHDRAWAL:

If a player is absent in any round without prior written intimation to the Chief Arbiter, he/she will be treated as having withdrawn from the tournament.



## REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS:

All participants in this State Championship must be registered with AICF and SBDS for the year 2026-27.



## ELECTRONIC DEVICES:

All electronic devices, including mobile, wristwatches (of any type), are strictly prohibited inside the tournament hall.

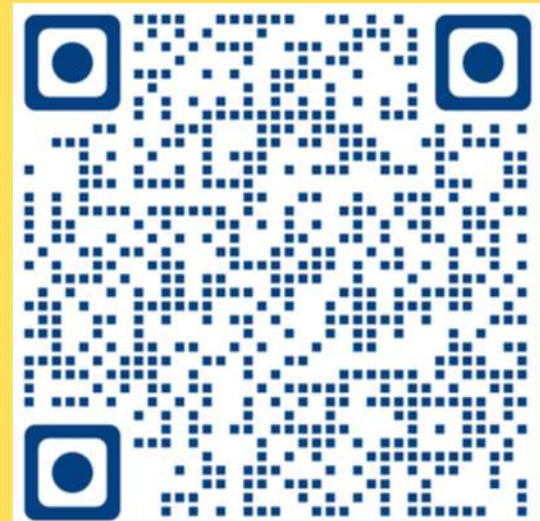
