5. Entry Fee Structure: Ordinary entry: Rs.500/- Special entry: Rs.1200/- Last date of entry is 24.05.2026 before 5.00 Pm. And the last date to register with a late fee of Rs. 200/- is 28.05.2026 before 5 PM.
6. System of Play: The Championship will be played under FIDE's Laws of Chess and the Swiss system.
7. Default Time : Default time for arriving to the chessboard is 15 minutes.
8. Time control: 40 Minutes + 5 Seconds increment. Number of rounds 8 The number of rounds may vary depending on the number of participants, and it will be decided in the players' meeting.
9. Tie Break : Following is the order of tie-break. 1) Buchholz Cut 1,2) Buchholz,3) Sonneborn Berger,4) Direct Encounter 5) The greater number of wins (forfeit included in case of a tie, cash prize will not be shared.
10. Protest : If any against the decision of the Chief Arbitor shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 500/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
11. Tournament Committee : The organizers will form a tournament committee for the smooth conduct of the Championship
12. Interpretation : For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the tournament committee shall be final and binding on all.
