- The Organizing Committee has the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason.



TOURNAMENT RULES



- The Rapid tournament is played according to Appendix A5 of the FIDE Laws of Chess (FIDE Handbook E.01).
- 4. 2. 1. Format: Swiss system, SIX rounds.
- 4. 2. 2. 1. Time control: 15 minutes + 10 seconds increment per move, starting from move 1.
- 4. 2. 2. 3. There is no default time. No penalty shall be imposed on a player if he/she is late for any of his/her games.

4. 2. 4. Tie-breaks

- 4. 2. 4. 1. If two or more players score the same points, the tie is broken by the following criteria, in order of priority:
 - (a) Buchholz Cut 1
 - (b) Buchholz
 - (c) Average rapid rating** of Opponents Cut 1 (AROC 1)
 - (d) Direct encounter between the players in tie
 - (e) Drawing of lots.
- Except as provided above, all tie-breaks are calculated as described in the Tie-Break Regulations (FIDE Handbook C07).
- Protest: Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a Protest fee of Rs. 1000/- within 10 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded, if the appeal is upheld

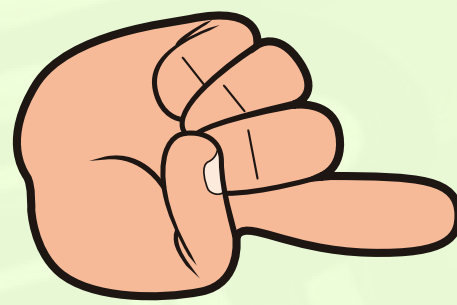

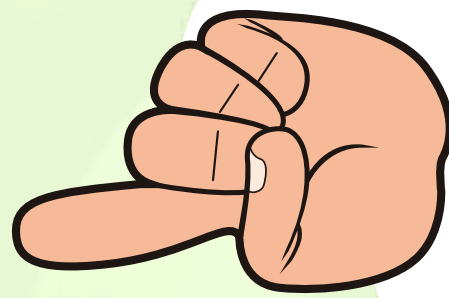

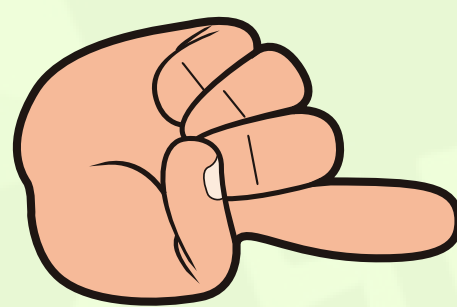
