TOURNAMENT DETAILS

Tournament Format : 8 Round Swiss System

Time Control : 90 Minutes + 30 Seconds

FIDE Rating : The event shall be FIDE Rated

ELIGIBILITY

- **Players must be born on or after 01 January 2007.**
- **A valid AICF Registration for the year 2026-27 is compulsory.**
- **Every player must possess a valid FIDE ID before the commencement of the tournament.**
- **Entries received without fulfilling the above requirements shall not be accepted.**

SELECTION

The Top Four Boys and Top Four Girls shall qualify to represent Madhya Pradesh in the National Junior Chess Championship 2026, scheduled to be held in West Bengal from 27 October to 04 November 2026.

AGE PROOF

Each participant must produce a valid certificate to prove his /her age. Certificates from School will not be accepted. Certificates should preferably be from the Panchayat, Municipality or Corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without date of birth certificates will not be allowed to participate. The date of birth certificates registered within one year of the birth of the player alone will be recognized and allowed to participate. No District association shall recommend any player who doesn't come under the above criteria. If any doubt arises about the claimed age of a player, the Tournament Committee has the right to refer the player during the championship for a due evaluation of age by competent medical experts. A player if declared over-age by such experts shall not continue in the championship and the matter shall be reported to AICF. Protest about the age of players may be made to the Chief Arbiter in writing along with a fee of Rs.5000/- per player. This will not be refunded. No protest about over age of a player will be entertained after second round of the championship. Only the Coach or Manager deputed by the participating DISTRICT Chess Association can lodge such protests. The Tournament Committee has the right to decide the day, time and place for such medical evaluation of age. AICF / Organizers will have the right to refer any player to the medical evaluation of age at any time during the Championship. Players refusing to take the test as decided by the Tournament Committee shall be deemed to have failed the test and shall be disqualified from the Championship.

Why a Classical Time Control?

As this championship serves as the official selection event for the Madhya Pradesh team, the tournament is being conducted in the classical format (90 minutes + 30 seconds increment) to ensure a fair and accurate assessment of every player's strength. This is the purest form of chess and mirrors the time control used at the National Junior Chess Championship, allowing the selected players to gain valuable experience under the same playing conditions they will face at the national level.

FIDE LAWS OF CHESS

The Championship shall be conducted strictly in accordance with the latest FIDE Laws of Chess, FIDE Rating Regulations, FIDE Fair Play Regulations and all applicable AICF Rules.

FAIR PLAY REGULATIONS

The Championship shall strictly follow the latest FIDE Fair Play Regulations.

Players may be subjected to Fair Play screening, random checks and anti-cheating procedures at any stage of the tournament.

The organizers reserve the right to use electronic screening devices and other measures as prescribed by FIDE.

DEFAULT TIME

The default time shall be 30 minutes from the scheduled commencement of the round.

Players arriving after the expiry of the default time shall lose the game unless otherwise decided by the Chief Arbiter in accordance with the FIDE Laws of Chess.

ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY

Mobile phones, smart watches, earphones and all electronic communication devices are strictly prohibited inside the playing hall unless specifically permitted under the FIDE Laws of Chess.

Violation of this rule may result in penalties including loss of game or expulsion from the tournament.

DRESS CODE

All participants are expected to maintain proper decorum and wear decent attire throughout the Championship.

The organizers reserve the right to refuse entry to players wearing inappropriate clothing.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation shall not be provided by the organizers.

Participants are requested to make their own accommodation arrangements. A list of nearby hotels and guest houses can be shared on request.
