Tournament System: -

1. The tournament will be played under the Swiss System, governed by the latest FIDE rules for chess.
2. No of Rounds will be decided during Technical Meeting.
3. Each session will be of 30 minutes with a 30 second increment from the first move.
4. Latest FIDE Tie-break rules will be applicable.
5. Any protests must be submitted in writing within 15 minutes from the completion of the game, along with a protest fee of Rs. 500. The fee is refundable if the protest is upheld.
6. The decision of the Appeals Committee will be final and binding on all participants.
7. The organiser reserves the right to reject any entry.
