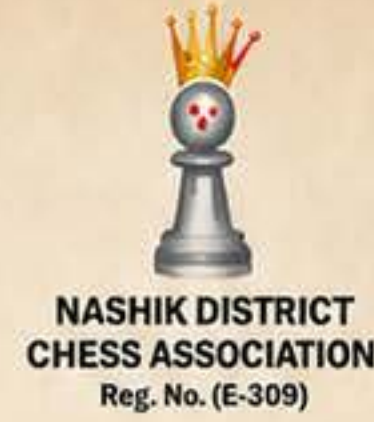

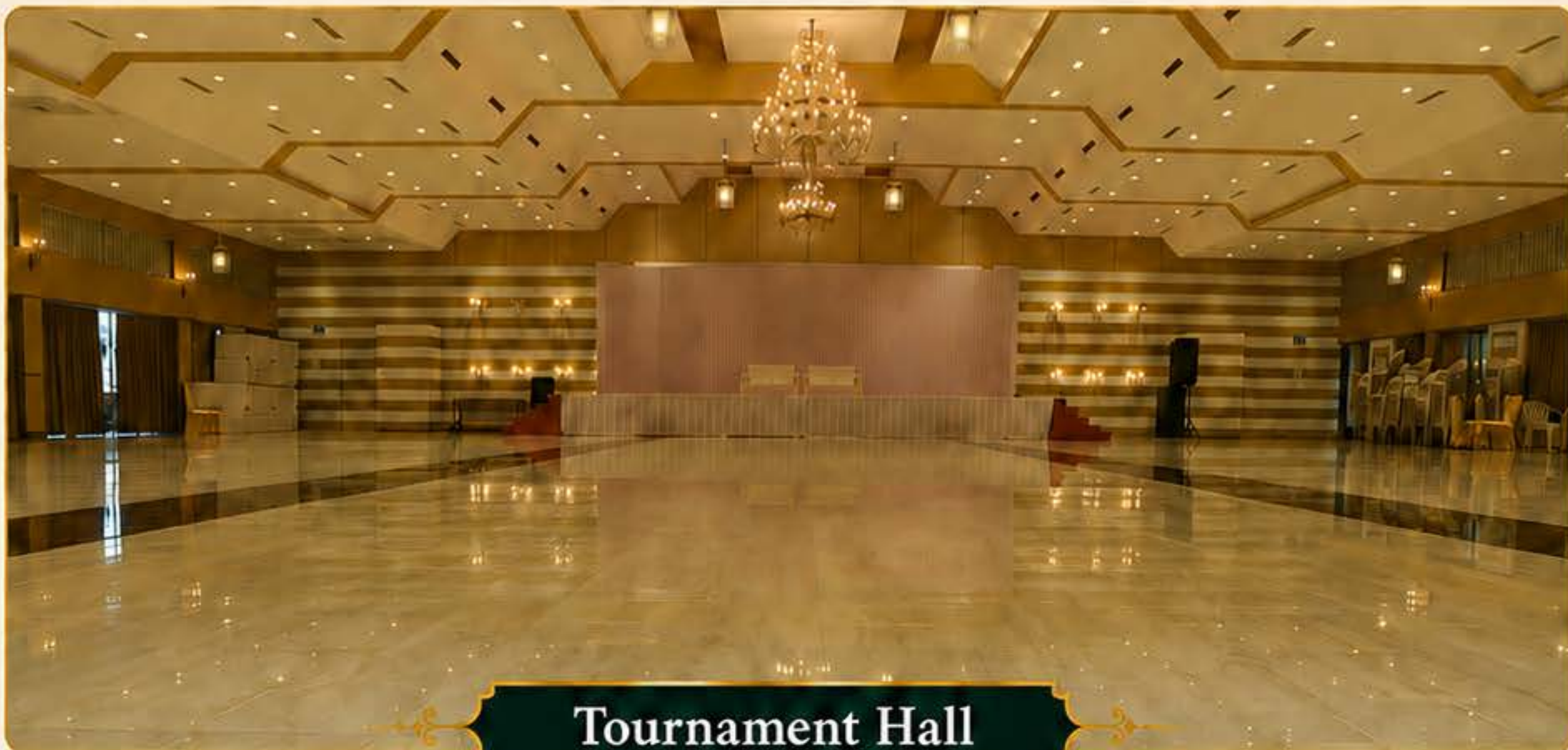

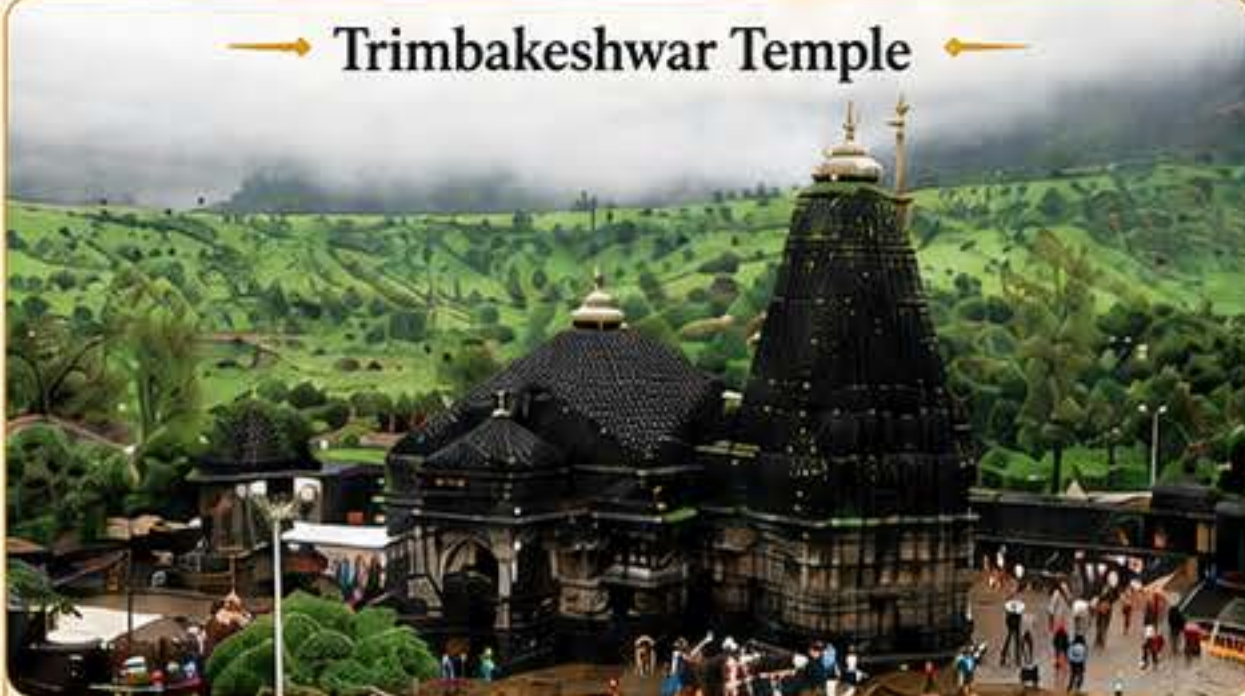
KUMBH MELA 2026
